More than \$800,000 in capital improvements

Over the past year, Hillside Hospital officials made multiple facility improvements and upgrades. Dollars were also invested in a new radiological room, additional anesthesia units, a new centrifuge for the laboratory, and room renovation and equipment for our cardiac rehabilitation program.

In fact, we invested more than \$800,000 in our facility last year which, in addition to the above, included technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and important facility upkeep and maintenance.

Contributing to our local tax base

Last year, Hillside Hospital paid \$1,002,564 in taxes that have helped support our city, county and state. This included sales taxes as well as property taxes. These dollars help support

local schools, the development of roads, the recruitment of business and industry, and other vital community services.

Helping those in need

Hillside Hospital has provided more than \$45.7 million in uncompensated care, which includes the amounts not covered by Medicare and Medicaid. The amount includes more than \$4.6 million in charity care and bad debt, incurred as we served many people without the financial resources to pay for basic health services.

Adding new physicians

Hillside Hospital recently added several specialists to their highly respected medical staff including an OB/GYN, an internist and a urologist.

One of our community's major employers

With an annual payroll of more than \$13.5 million and 250 employees, Hillside Hospital is one of the largest employers in the county. This means that our staff and their families attend many of the same schools, shop at the same grocery stores, and volunteer their time and resources for the same organizations as you do.

"Charity and other uncompensated care" includes the amounts not covered by Medicare and Medicaid as well as charity care and bad debts. "Physician recruitment costs" include recruitment costs and support of new physicians' initial practice establishment in the community. Payroll includes consolidated salaries, wages, benefits and contract labor costs. "Capital investments" include facility expansions/renovations, equipment purchases, technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and routine facility upkeep and maintenance.
